The speakers for the camp were Mr. Moatoshi Imsong, State Secretary, UESI Nagaland and Rev. Achu Chang, Executive secretary, CBLT, along with Mr. Yabang longkumer, Pastor, CBCD and Mrs. Flora Leivon K. Panmei, Administrator, Shamrock Hospital, Dimapur, as resource persons and Mr. Edward Marhizii, Co-ordinator, UESI, Dimapur, as the Camp director. Altogether 28 persons attended the camp.
